#### **Statement**

"[Depiction of] life is a magic act: it is all done with mirrors"

"A portrait evolves by coming to understand, often in a short space of time, a complex and unique personality. The artist views the sitter through the mirrored confines of his or her personal life experience; the sitter presents to the artist another mirror – an image of how best he or she would like to be seen and remembered. The soul of the painting is captured between these two perceptions; without this soul, "achieving likeness" or "employing technique", however masterful, is insufficient."
