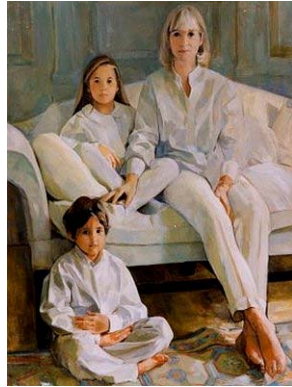
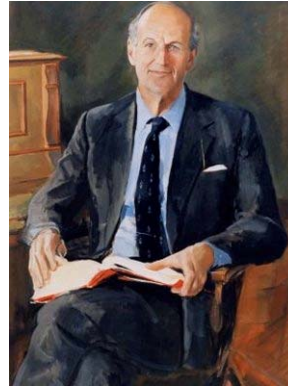

Introduction For Robert Beckett, life as an artist began in 1985 whilst travelling the world after obtaining a degree in Biochemistry. It wasn't until 1989 that he began to concentrate solely on art.
